### **Tri Skills and Investigations Roster**

Your child has brought home their new timetable and Investigations Roster in their red Library bag. **Please note that the day for Library has changed and is now on Tuesday. The red bag must now be brought in on Tuesday (or beforehand).**

### **Tri Skills**
