Inquiry

Our current line of inquiry is centred around the environment with our big idea being 'Our environmental choices impact the future health of our world.'

Students will unpack this through several smaller lines of inquiry, including;

- -What is the environmental state of our school?
- -What does being a 5 star school mean and how do we maintain it?
- -How does our community support the health of our environment?
- -How do we ensure our planet is healthy for future generations?

Students will explore a range of literature, including digital texts during English lessons to further enhance their understandings and also through incidental mathematical opportunities as well. Children will continue to be challenged by words relating to these lines of inquiry, investigating spelling rules and patterns and revising vowel sounds with greater complexity.

Homework
