### 5/6 Expo

Year 1 students enjoyed visiting the 5/6 Expo on Tuesday 1st May. There were lots of exciting projects based on the topic 'Immigration'. Students were inquisitive and excited to ask the year 5/6s about their projects to learn and understand what they were presenting.



### What we are doing:

#### *In Literacy:*

In Writing are looking at the 5 senses and incorporating these into our writing. Students will reflect on a memory in relation to the senses. We continue to focus on punctuation and how to correctly use full stops, capital letters, commas, exclamation marks and question marks. Students are also looking at lowercase and uppercase letters and how to use these correctly in their writing.

In Reading we are exploring a range of texts including information texts, narratives and digital modes of text. These texts support students learning of the brain and how it helps us learn. We continue to encourage all the students to read a variety of texts inside of school as well as outside of school. This will help strengthen their recognition of titles, use of pictures, text and other clues when decoding, and comprehending when reading.

#### *In Maths:*

Our current focus in maths is number patterns. This includes looking at numbers represented as a number line, counting by 2s, 5s, 10s and making other connections/identifying other patterns. We are also looking at measurement and will be comparing the ranging heights of the students in the class. Students will also look at probability and the chances of rolling an odd or even number.
